PIMP OUT YOUR DEN WITH HOME-MADE BUNTING



No fort would be complete without those all-important finishing touches. Make your mark and pimp out your den by printing our Fort Night bunting or follow our step-by-step instructions to create your own instead.

What you'll need -

- Paper or card (enough for at least 6 triangles)
- Ribbon or String
- · Glue, a stapler or tape
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Any craft items you'd like to use to decorate
- Blue tac/safety pins/drawing pins to hang
- Draw a triangle on some cardboard and cut it out to use as your bunting template. You may prefer longer, narrower triangles, or shorter, wider ones. The choice is up to you!
- STEP 2: Use the template to draw around, repeating until you have as many flags as you'd like to hang (we recommend at least 6 for maximum effect).
- Cut out your triangles and then get crafty to decorate as you wish have a look to find what's at home to help make your bunting as colourful as possible!
- STEP 4: Once you're happy with your decoration (make sure that if you've used any paint or glitter that they have had chance to dry!) you can assemble your bunting. Using glue, a stapler or tape, attach the triangles (at equal distance apart) to your ribbon or string.

REMEMBER – Leave about 12 inches at each end to hana.

You can pin or tape your bunting to your den or around the room.

There you have it, your very own handmade bunting! The perfect finishing touch for your Fort!
