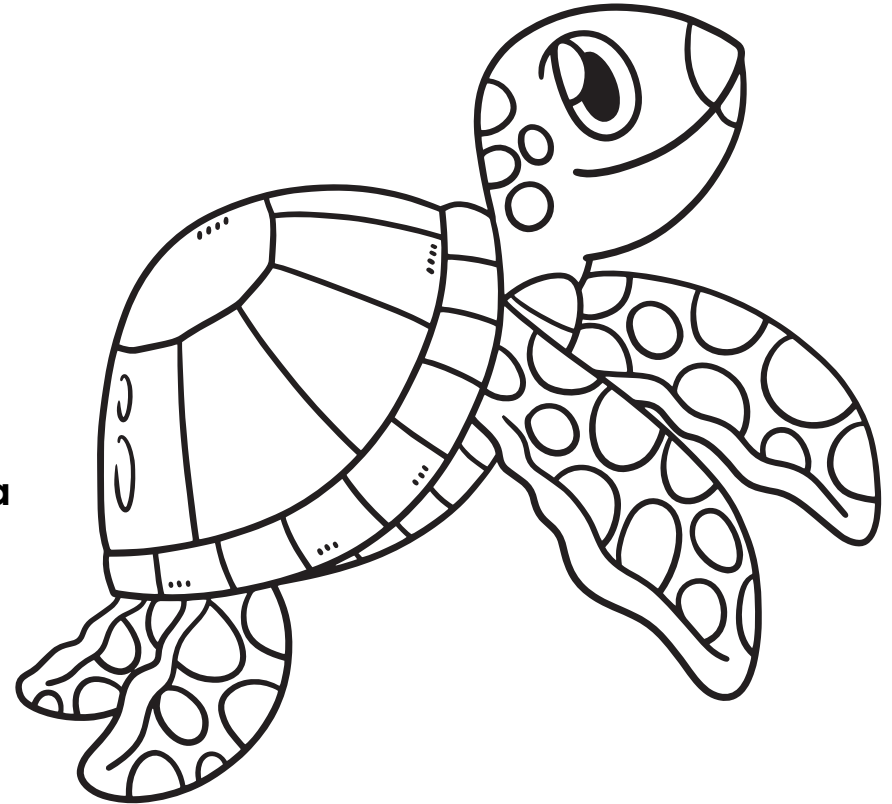
- How do I do it?
